Hot summer days are particularly suited for a well-chilled bottle of rosé. What could possibly enhance the experience of a dry, crisp wine that's enticingly hued? Bubbles. Yes, still sparkling rosé and prosecco get plenty of attention.

Ruffino Prosecco Sale Price \$10.98
The celebrated Ruffino estate in Tuscany enters the popular Prosecco category with this brand-new wine. An Extra Dry expression with a tiny hint of sweetness, this bright sparkler delivers pear, honey and sweet peach.

Ruffino Sparkling Rose Sale Price \$10.98
Ruffino Sparkling Rosé is fresh and fragrant with notes of strawberry and slight hints of rose petals. On the palate this wine has elegant bubbles and refreshing acidity, offering alluring flavors of delicate red berries and white fruits that linger through the finish.

Estancia is translated from the Spanish word for "estate," and emphasizes our conviction that the world's best wines capture the essence of their place of origin. With over 30 years of experience, Estancia relies on the benefits of boutique-style winemaking techniques, including whole-cluster fermentation, gentle punch downs, and basket pressing. It is this crafting of the wines, from grapes to bottle, that results in our consistent and superior wine quality

Estancia Chardonnay Reg. Price \$11.99 . Sale Price \$9.98
Lush but fine-tuned aromas of lemon skin, pineapple, daffodil and melon are cut by chamomile and mineral tones on the edges of this good-deal wine. It's also well designed on the palate, where butter and oak-smoke flavors meet with chalky minerality, Asian pear flesh and jasmine notes

Estancia Sauvignon Blanc . . . Reg. Price \$11.99 . Sale Price \$9.98
Crystalline in appearance, this wine offers ripe fruit aromas of nectarine, kiwi and crisp Pink Lady apples, without being too flowery. Lots of minerality and lime pith appear on the lively palate, showing just a touch of tropicality but honing in on the grassy lemon-peel line. Ripe apples show on the finish.

Estancia Cabernet Sauvignon Reg. Price \$14.99 Sale Price \$10.98
Slightly shy dark fruit, spice and gravel aromas show on the nose of this affordably priced bottling. Cranberry, dried herb and mineral flavors are apparent on the palate, which finishes on a fruit punch note.

Estancia Zinfandel Reg. Price \$11.99 . Sale Price \$9.98
Here's a big, rich, tannic Zin, the kind that kicks butt in youth and will age. It's astringent with tannins now, but the core of blackberry and cherry fruit is powerful. Perfectly dry, this wine should develop nicely over the next several years

Estancia Pinot Noir. Reg. Price \$14.99 Sale Price \$10.98
Light pomegranate, red plum, cranberry and rose petals eventually show on the nose of this wine, which is somewhat simple at first. The palate delivers a solid sip, however, with snappy raspberry and graphite flavors, framed by grippy tannins and energetic acidity. Holds its own against much more expensive wines.

Estancia Merlot Reg. Price \$11.99 . Sale Price \$9.98
Generic Merlot, good, rich and full-bodied, without any noteworthy complexities. Berry and plum flavors drink dry, with pretty substantial tannins that need rich foods to cut through.

A HIKE THROUGH THE WEST COAST

Mark West Willamette Valley Pinot Noir **Reg. Price \$14.99** **Sale Price \$11.98**

A sweet, jammy Pinot Noir, with raspberry, cherry, licorice and sandalwood flavors, brightened by crisp acidity. Good as an introductory Pinot to explore the variety at a fair price.

Consentino "The Franc" Cabernet Franc **Reg. Price \$14.99** **Sale Price \$11.98**

Maple syrup and brown-sugar flavors are easy to detect in this ripe, full-bodied and just slightly sweet Lodi Cabernet Franc wine. Those flavors come from aging in new oak barrels or with oak add-ins, and will taste attractive to some and overdone to others.

Canoe Ridge "The Explorer" Red Blend **Reg. Price \$17.99** **Sale Price \$14.98**

This blend of Syrah, Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon leads with boysenberry, blackberry and sweet spice aromas, followed by full-bodied, lush fruit flavors. The tannins are a bit tacky, but it's otherwise appealing, showing pleasant balance.

Adorada Pinot Gris **Reg. Price \$12.99** **Sale Price \$10.98**

Crafted from premium California grapes in a sumptuously aromatic style, reminiscent of an ambrosial fragrance. The freshness of a coastal breeze brought to life through a vibrant blend of orange blossom and honeysuckle, with a touch of honeydew and lemon zest.

Butter Chardonnay **Reg. Price \$16.99** **Sale Price \$13.98**

A smoky, charred aroma and buttery, heavily toasted flavors clearly define this full-bodied Chardonnay. It's going for the full oak treatment with no apologies. Ripe pear and pineapple lurk underneath the smoke, clove and nutmeg overlay, and a bit of oak tannin combines with good acidity to give a welcome bite to the texture



SUMMER WHITES FROM AROUND THE WORLD

Nobilo Sauvignon Blanc **Reg. Price \$10.99** . . **Sale Price \$8.98**

Our Nobilo Sauvignon Blanc represents the best of what New Zealand has to offer, with classic flavors that consistently showcase the diverse qualities of our Marlborough vineyards, year after year. Fruit was primarily selected from vineyards in Marlborough's Wairau Valley, which provided complementary layers of tropical fruit flavors. A smaller portion from vineyards in the Awatere Valley provided balance with citrus-driven, fresh, crisp, and vibrant flavors.

North by North West Chardonnay . . **Reg. Price \$9.99** . . . **Sale Price \$7.98**

North by Northwest located in The Columbia Valley AVA is renowned for the ability to grow high quality fruit in an area of unique terroir. Subdued aromas of melon and apple lead to medium-bodied fruit flavors. It comes off as a bit generic, with the variety seeming to get lost

King Estate Pinot Gris **Reg. Price \$18.99** . . **Sale Price \$14.98**

King Estate consistently delivers, and this is a delicious, creamy, textural wine. Full-throttle fruit combines lemon, lime, pineapple and candied citrus rind, underscored by refreshing minerality. Give it a slight chill and drink now through 2020.

Ruffino Il Ducale Pinot Grigio . . **Reg. Price \$14.99** . . **Sale Price \$11.98**

Straw yellow with a hint of gold. Fresh and fragrant with bright aromas of pineapple, white peach, and tropical fruit accompanied by delicate white flowers and sage, followed by flavors of apple and pear. The acidity is firm but balanced, working with the ripe fruit taste profile to confer freshness and a mineral touch to the wine. A perfect accompaniment to fresh seafood salsa, linguine, spinach gnocchi, tomato bruschetta, Parmigiano Reggiano, or Pecorino Romano

St. Francis Sauvignon Blanc **Reg. Price \$12.99** . . **Sale Price \$10.98**

St. Francis Winery will consistently produce luscious, elegant, fruit driven wines that best interpret the richness and distinct varietal characteristics of Sonoma's unique, diverse terroir.
